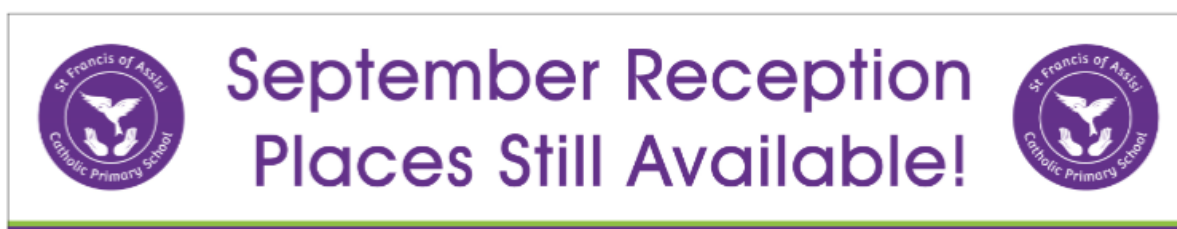

Please would parents support us in the following:

- For safeguarding reasons, we would ask parents to say goodbye to their children at the school door and not to come into school with them in the morning. - Please don't allow your child to play in the Reception playground after school.
