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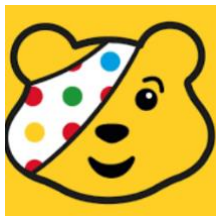


## **CHILDREN IN NEED – Friday 19<sup>th</sup> November – non-uniform day**
