## SPORTS DAY

Here is a brief outline for Sports Day 2022 so you know what to expect on the day. In the morning, there will be 30 teams taking part in carousel sports activities (e.g. bean bag toss, standing long jump, obstacle course). Each team will consist of children from Year 6 all the way down to Reception, and siblings being in the same team to make it easier for adults to support their children. All activities will take place on the field; parents are welcome to join us at 9.30 am for the start of the first activity.

We would also like to invite parents to stay for a picnic lunch with their children on their field. Please join in and bring your own picnic to enjoy and share with your children. Don't forget to bring a blanket to sit on! On this day, the school kitchen will only be offering school-packed lunches so all children can join in with the picnic.

In the afternoon, KS2 children will remain on the field to race in the finals only of the track events. This week, heats for the track events will take place in your child's PE lesson. We will have finals for the sprint, 200m, 400m (Year 6 only) and egg and spoon relay! All adults are welcome to stay for the races, but please be aware that only the finalists will be racing. We will however, hold a Parents' Race too. Additionally, there are no races for EYFS and KS1 children.

We hope you can join us to share this wonderful day, and fingers crossed for a lovely bright day.
