**4M Clare** - for her very careful work in Art. It is producing beautiful results!

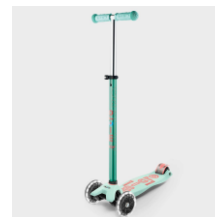
**Hariel** - for his mindfulness during our tests. Well done Hariel and excellent focus.
