AFTER SCHOOL CLUB (ASC)



A few parents have enquired if they can just pay £5 for ASC between 4.30 and 5.30 on occasions when their child has a club held by either Premier, Tennis, Science or Art organisations. Unfortunately, the answer is no.

The reason is that our ASC is funded by the children who attend. If a place is taken between 4.30 and 5.30 pm, this takes a place that could have been offered at £10 from 3.15 to 6pm. Our ASC would then not make enough money, we would have to reduce staffing and offer even less places to students at St Francis.

I know this is not the answer you wanted but to keep the prices low and the children safe we cannot change this structure.

On another note, this is a reminder that ASC does not give refunds unless there are exceptional mitigating circumstances or payment has been received twice accidently.

Friday 15th December –Into Opera Unwrapped for Christmas? – Years 3 to 6

Opera Unwrapped is a popular Into Opera concert series where opera singers share some of their favourite music with audiences and share stories and anecdotes about what that music means to them. These concerts always involve a lot of laughter, conversation, as well as... of course... some fun and festive music from the world of opera, films and Christmas music.

On Friday 15th December Into Opera will be holding their biggest concert yet: **Opera Unwrapped for Christmas at St Andrews Hall Norwich**.

There is a school's version of the concert during the day and then there will be a concert on sale for the public in the evening which our school choir are invited to perform in. Into Opera are teaming up with the extraordinary ensemble Britten Sinfonia, one of the best classical ensembles in the UK and the only professional orchestra in the East of England. Into Opera soloists include the much in demand soprano Alison Langer, internationally renowned mezzo soprano Yvonne Howard who is a long-term friend and collaborator of Into Opera, as well as the outstanding baritone James Cleverton. The event will be conducted by the award-winning conductor John Andrews.
