LEARNING THIS WEEK

Year 1 This week Year 1 have written a Pentecostal Promise, learnt about holidays and holydays and thought about how to say sorry when we've made a mistake. In maths we have been learning how to find half of a shape.

Year 2 have turned their attention to the Sonoran Desert this week, writing detailed setting descriptions of what can be found there. In art, we created beautiful pieces inspired by the Aroura Borealis. It was so lucky to be able to use recent pictures from last weekend to share with the children!

Year 3 have been researching Canadian animals, especially the lynx, the moose, the eagle, the wolf and the polar bear. They have looked at the particular features, diet and habitats and how these aspects help them live in that part of the world. The children have started to create their own 'hybrid' animal! They are collecting information for a factsheet about their animal. Have you ever seen a moose with wings? Perhaps you will soon!

Year 4 This week we have completed the next stage in creating our own 3D model islands. We were inspired by reading Kensuke's Kingdom by Michael Morpurgo and last week we made a structure out of newspaper and masking tape. This week we used papier mache to add depth and body to our islands, ready to paint them to match our designs. This was a very messy lesson but a fun time was had by all!

Year 5 have been designing pouches for ice lollies out of materials which they believe to be the best thermal insulators. Testing will take place on Friday where we will see which pouch keeps an ice lolly frozen for the longest time. Dragon's Den here we come! In RE we have looked at how the disciples were left with the Holy Spirit after Jesus ascended into heaven and how the Early Church began.
